DESCRIPTION

ROCKBOND MORTAR PLASTERCISER (RB 6.22) is a liquid admixture that is a blend of special powders mixed in a solution to form a plasticiser to improve the workability in mortars and renders.

- Used with all types of Portland cement/lime mixes.

- Helps reduce the water content.
- Can also be used in Fibre-reinforced plaster.
- Increases working time of mortars and plasters in hot weather.

USES

- To be used in all types of mortar and renders to improve workability and cohesion.

PACKAGING & SIZES

20 Litre and 200 Litre non-refundable containers.

DOSAGE

Dosage Rate Approx: 110mls/40kg cement (approx 1 tablespoon/5kg cement)

NOTE: 1 heaped shovelful of cement = 3 - 5kg.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

ROCKBOND MORTAR PLASTERCISER (RB 6.22) is best premixed in the mixing water. This way, the dosage is more easily controlled.

CURING

As with all rendering and plaster coats container ROCKBOND MORTAR PLASTERCISER (RB 6.22) they should be cured with Rockbond Curing Compounds.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Rockbond Special Concrete Products are generally quite harmless, provided normal precautions are taken when handling chemicals.

Avoid contact with food stuff and utensils. Avoid prolonged skin contact. Wear protective clothing, gloves, goggles etc. In the event of contamination, wash thoroughly with water. If the eyes or mouth are affected, wash with clean water and obtain medical attention.
